SUBJECT: Resolution 29-2018; Declaring Elected Candidates to Serve as City Councilmembers for Four Year Terms.

RECOMMENDED COUNCIL ACTION:

That the City Council adopt Resolution No. 29-2018; A Resolution declaring candidates elected to serve as City Councilmembers for four year terms.

SUMMARY:

The Election for City Council was held on November 6, 2018. There were three (3) incumbents and one (1) candidate running for three (3) seats. The election results are attached to Proposed Resolution No. 29-2018.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

At the May 15, 2018 City Council meeting the City Council adopted Resolution No.12-2018 ordering an election, requesting county consolidation of the election, and determining charges for candidate's statements.

DISCUSSION:

This year's election consisted of three (3) open seats for City Council, and Measures A & B which would extend the ¼% Sales Tax sunset date until March 2030.

CITY FISCAL IMPACT:

Fifteen thousand dollars was included in the 2018-2019 budget to cover election costs.

RESOLUTION NO. 29-2018

RESOLUTION 29-2018; DECLARING ELECTED CANDIDATES TO SERVE AS CITY COUNCILMEMBERS FOR FOUR YEAR TERMS.

WHEREAS, a consolidated general municipal election was held and conducted by the County Clerk of the County of Tehama, State of California, on Tuesday, the 6th of November 2018, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and regularly given in time, form and manner as provided by the law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects said election was held and conducted and the votes cast thereat, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Election Code of the State of California, for the holding of consolidated elections in cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 61-1984, adopted December 4, 1984, the County Clerk of the County of Tehama canvassed the returns of said election and has certified the results to this City Council; and

WHEREAS, said results are received, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED BLUFF, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there were seven (7) voting precincts established for the purpose of holding said election consisting of election precincts in the City of Red Bluff, as established for the hold of state and county elections.

Section 2. That said consolidated election was held for the purpose of electing the following officers of said City as required by the laws relating to cities in the State of California; to wit:

- Three (3) members of the City Council for the City of Red Bluff for the full terms of four years.

Section 3. That the whole number of votes cast in said election in said City, including absent voter ballots, are contained in the document marked "Attachment A", certified by the Board of Supervisors, County of Tehama.

Section 4. That the names of the persons voted for at said election for Member of the City Council of said City are as follows:

- **Gary Jones**
- **Daniele Eyestone**
- **Rob Schmid**
- **Kris Deiters**

Section 5. The City Council does declare and determine that:

****The City of Red Bluff is an Equal Opportunity Provider****

Gary Jones was elected as Member of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years.

Daniele Eyestone was elected as Member of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years.

Kris Deiters was elected as Member of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of said City, a statement of results of said election, showing:

1. The whole number of votes cast in the City.
2. The names of the persons voted for.
3. For what office each person was voted for.
4. The number of votes given at each precinct to each person.
5. The number of votes given in the City to each person.

Section 7. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and shall deliver to each of such persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by her and duly authenticated.

Section 8. That the City Clerk or designee shall administer to each person elected, the Oath of Office prescribed in the State Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe thereto and file the same in the office of the City Clerk.

Whereupon, each and all said persons so elected shall be immediately inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

Section 9. That the Deputy City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution; shall enter the same in the book of original Resolutions of said City; and shall make a minute of the passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City Council of said City, in the minutes of the meeting at which the same is passed and adopted.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED BLUFF:
