SUBJECT: Other Agency Representation by City Council

RECOMMENDED COUNCIL ACTION:

City Council to approve the adjustments to the Fire Ad Hoc Committee and the City Council Law Enforcement Sub Committee titles.

SUMMARY:

Each December the City Council reviews the current Councilmember assignments as City Representatives to other agencies and committees. At the January 15, 2019 City Council meeting, Councilmember Clay Parker asked that the Fire Ad Hoc Committee and the City Council Law Enforcement Sub Committee have the following changes made to the titles.

- Fire Committee (remove “Ad Hoc”)
- City Council Law Enforcement Committee (remove “Sub”)
- The title of the committee list is proposed to change from “OTHER AGENCY REPRESENTATION” to “CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS”

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

The City Council last reviewed the other agency representation assignments on December 4, 2018. At the January 15, 2019 City Council meeting, Councilmember Parker requested changes to the Fire Ad Hoc Committee and the City Council Law Enforcement Sub Committee titles.

DISCUSSION:

The titles of the Fire Ad Hoc Committee and the City Council Law Enforcement Sub Committee are misleading. The Fire Committee is not an Ad Hoc Committee and the City Council Law Enforcement Committee is not a Sub Committee. In addition, the previously titled “OTHER AGENCY REPRESENTATION” list is not limited to other agencies, it reflects assignments to City Committees as well. Accordingly, Staff requests that the City Council change the name of Committee list to “CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS”

CITY FISCAL IMPACT:
